## 2. MPCA Update:

- a. Cycle 2 TMDL & WRAPS Reports:
  - Overall nothing formal yet. Draft reports will begin this winter, hopeful to have them done Summer 2022.
    - TMDL: 13 impairments for 9 sections of streams will likely get TMDLs, and 8 additional nitrate TMDLs may also happen for 8 sections of streams upstream of existing nitrate TMDLs.
    - 2. WPARS: MPCA still working out how the Cycle 2 WRAPS reports will look, will be greatly reduced in length. Plan to start meeting Oct/Nov to start conversations with local partners on content.

#### 3. Interpretive Kiosks review and discussion:

a. Sheila received a USB drive with file info and sizes for signs at the interpretive kiosk stations. They were created by the U of M Center for Changing Landscapes and MPCA, with 6 to be located in Stewartville, 5 in Preston and 5 in Hokah. They are 27 inches x 36 inches. Estimated to run \$16,000-\$19,000 in total, to print the signs and have them installed; a list of companies has been reached out to for quotes. Because of our finding sources, if the group decides to use these signs, the Clean Water, Land & Legacy logo will need to be added, and potentially the RR 1W1P logo and SWCD logos.
