

## **Outputs and Outcomes**

<u>Outputs</u>: Two waterways, plus one funded in part with FY10 funds and reported with FY10 projects, totaling 1870 feet, 1000 feet of terrace with underground outlet, and six farmstead windbreaks were installed in 2011.

\*All remaining FY11 funds are encumbered in eight cost share contracts.

#### Outcomes:

Water pollution reduction estimates for these projects: Reduction in Soil Loss = 28 tons per year



Waterway needs are often evident after a rain event. A waterway's purpose is to:

- convey runoff from terraces, diversions or other water concentrations without causing erosion or flooding.
- reduce gully erosion.
- improve water quality.

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
