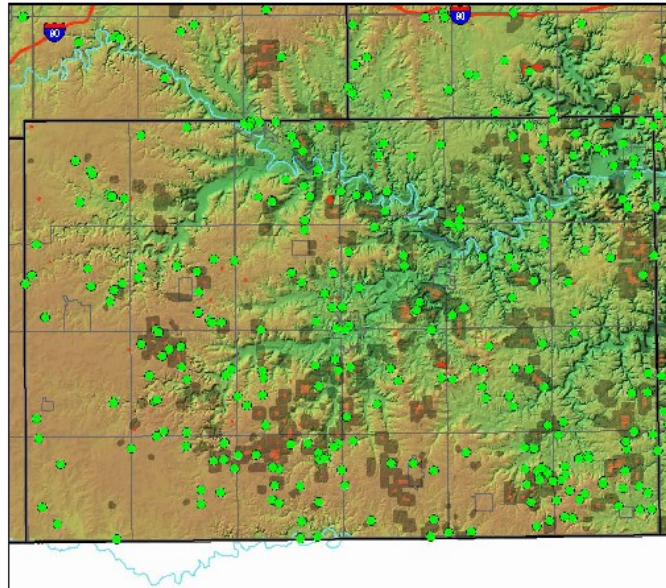

#### Outputs and Outcomes

Outputs: One well decommissioning, one waterway (3100 feet) and one terrace restoration (2100 feet) were completed in 2013. Treated acres = 17.2. Encumbered funds total \$22,972.88 for five grassed waterways, five farmstead windbreaks, one well decommissioning, and two terraces with underground outlets.

Outcomes:

Water pollution reduction estimates for projects completed:  
Reduction in Soil Loss = 13 T/acre/year



- Waterway needs are often evident after a rain event. A waterway's purpose is to:
- convey runoff from terraces, diversions or other water concentrations without causing erosion or flooding.
  - reduce gully erosion.
  - improve water quality.
