

## **Outputs and Outcomes**

### Outputs:

2013: Four projects have contracts approved encumbering \$2,988.85. No projects were completed in 2013

2014: 1 grassed waterway (1430'), 1 water and sediment control basin, 1 terrace (1182'), and 2 well decommissionings were completed.

2015: 2 grassed waterways (4050' total) and 1 terrace with outlets (625') plus completion of 2 grassed waterways that also used FY2013 funds.

### Outcomes:

Water pollution reduction estimates for projects completed: Reduction in Soil Loss = 48.1 T/year



Waterway needs are often evident after a rain event. A waterway's purpose is to:

- convey runoff from terraces, diversions or other water concentrations without causing erosion or flooding.
- reduce gully erosion.
- improve water quality.
