

Outputs and Outcomes

Outputs:

2015: Two FY2016 cost share contracts were approved in 2015. No projects completed using FY2016 grant funds.

2016: Six projects completed in 2016; four grassed waterways totaling 5,560 feet and two terrace projects totaling 2,050 feet.

Outcomes:

Water pollution reduction estimates for projects completed:
Estimated Soil Savings = 27.87 T/year
Estimated Phosphorus reduction = 14.4 lbs./year
Estimated Sediment (TSS) reduction = 12.01 T/year



Waterway needs are often evident after a rain event. A waterway's purpose is to:

- convey runoff from terraces, diversions or other water concentrations without causing erosion or flooding.
- reduce gully erosion.
- improve water quality.

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
