Cover crop trainings for SWCD and NRCS staff will be held June 18-22, 2018 at five locations around the state in cooperation with NRCS. Grant funds will be used for staff wages for the Area 7 Soil Health Technician to prepare for and conduct the trainings plus expenses for mileage, lodging and meals. Additional trainings were held in August, and with funds remaining, more are planned for 2019.

Outputs

Outputs:

5/25/18-6/22/18: The Soil Health Technician planned and conducted statewide cover crop trainings in conjunction with NRCS June 18-22, 2018, at five locations: Marshall, Fergus Falls, Crookston, Erskine and Mora. Expenses include the Soil Health Technician time for planning, conducting and following up on the five trainings plus mileage, meals and lodging expenses. Tech 132 hrs @\$49.60

6/23-12/31/18: The Soil Health Technician assisted with planning and conducting cover Crop trainings held August 8 in Oronoco (12 attendees) and August 21 (16 attendees) in Cologne for both SWCD and NRCS staff. Expenses are for the Tech's staff time: 54.5 hrs @\$49.60. Grant agreement was amended to extend the expiration date to 6/30/19 for additional trainings in 2019. Planning began in December for six seeding trainings to be held statewide the last week of February to March 1st. Tech's staff time 6 hrs @\$49.60.
